

Foxhunting Match Game

This is just a simple match game whereby the member will match cards of one color to cards of another color. On each card is printed some aspect of foxhunting and will have a corresponding mate. For example the card reading “Tally Ho” needs to be matched with it’s mate reading “You see a fox”. The answer key is listed below.

There are two lists of cards on the following pages. It is best to print the two sets on card or cover stock paper so it is easier to handle and will last for more than one class/person. It is also a good idea to print the two sets on different color paper, but this is just a visual issue – it is not critical because every card in the first set has an “A” in the corner, and the second set has a “B” in the corner. Different colors and the A and B are used so the student knows he/she is matching one card from one set to a card from the other set. For our study group, I printed one game for each of the students. I found they participated more when responsible for themselves, rather than relying on that one member who knows all the answers... I use this after we have reviewed foxhunting, as a game for them to practice what they have just learned.
